**Meeting called to order at:** 6:35 pm via Teams. A quorum was declared.

### Principal's Report - Tim MacLeod

Thank you to PAC for the **purchased projectors**  
4 more classes to be finished by the end of the year.

**Outdoor space** – not too many warm days so far, but students are using the area actively.

Continuing with **staggered beginning and end times**. Will evaluate next year if things go back to normal or stay as is. Handwashing continues as “trained”.

Small Group presentations are in place. Mixing of cohorts is starting again.

Still have a lot of students wearing masks – happy medium between the two.  
Protocols still in place and are being followed. The school is happy to being able to bring back speakers.

**School planning committee** – second meeting is scheduled for tonight.

Goal #1 / Goal #2 – working on refinement of the goal message (assessment tools)  
More information will be available on the website.

Online / Social Media / Anti Bullying – school liaison officers in the building. Only **2 officers** in the School District.

**Track & Field** as started as of this morning. Program lead by N. Dale together with some parent volunteers.

Encouraging new students to join. Out of grade 4/5/6/7 only the grade 7 have been doing track and field due to the stop during Covid. It is a new activity for most students.

**Field Trips** are slowly starting again, still lots of paperwork involved which causes hesitation.

Some **one-day programs for outdoor school** are back in place, starting with grade 3s followed by 6/7s. No overnight programs this year.

**Boundary Ready / Set / Grow** program for kids aged 3-5, a very popular event with an attendance of 30-40 students. Primarily targeting Kindergarten kids this.

**Kindergarten orientation on June 10th** will happen in person.

Tomorrow April 20 – **student passwords** will be reset. It wasn't a smooth process for teachers. Teachers are on alert.

**Fun-Day on May 20** – currently in planning

**Playland** – looking at an alternative option, due to mixed attendance by high school students

One Ukrainian Family has joined Boundary Elementary, potentially more families to come. Waiting for the family to settle in to the community.

**Hot Dog Day** notices were sent home today (April 19)

#### Chair's Report – Sue Cleall

**Online Auction** – will go live on Sunday, a link will be distributed via the school newsletter on the weekend. Estimated to make a 60-70% return of market value. Lots of great items to be auctioned off: Principal for a Day / Yoga / Hotel / Beauty / Pizza Party for a kid's class / etc.

**Carnival – June 10;** 4 to 7 pm on the backfield this year.

Call for volunteers is still on, the first meetings with volunteers have happened. Thank you, all volunteers, for participating and bringing new ideas.

Rides, Games, Climbing Wall ...

Businesses for sponsorship have come forward already, but we are looking for **more sponsors**.

Estimated **sponsor level \$450** per ride. Looking to cover at least \$2500.

Lynn Valley Lions will be donating the food. Lions have a very large budget to use and will be bringing food and equipment. PAC is looking for more volunteers for set up, break down and serving the food items.

2 Years ago was the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary for Boundary, the theme will be 50 years (=+2) to make up for the missed opportunity.

Volunteer sign up sheet will be distributed before the event for more parents to sign on.

**Neufield Farms** fundraiser will happen again, the pickup is just around the carnival date, with opening of fundraiser May 12.

**Stream of Dreams**, approximate cost 15\$k, through the grant should be getting 9K covered. The grant was filed and will hopefully approved.
